This is a notice to ALL Sleep Technologists and Technicians currently working in the State of New Jersey:

The Polysomnography Practice Act of New Jersey requires that all sleep personnel working in the state of New Jersey apply for Licensure by no later than February 10, 2011.

Facts you should know:

- This is a "**one time only**" grandfathering opportunity for all those who are currently working in NJ as a technician or technologist.
- Once the deadline is passed, the process for obtaining a license will require that you meet the same standards and regulations that new all new graduates/trainees entering the sleep industry must meet regardless of holding your RPSGT or years of experience.
- Failure to meet this deadline can seriously impact your ability to continue working in New Jersey and obtaining future jobs.
